In order to pick up your class schedule at registration, you will need to complete the forms in this packet (internet form, health forms), sign up for a locker (seniors only), pay any outstanding fees, and pay registration fees for this year (class fee, internet fee).

Welcome to the 2007-2008 school year. As the new athletic director at EVHS, I am looking forward to working with everyone that is involved with athletics from parents, students-athletes, and fans. This will be a learning experience for me so please bear with me as I learn the ropes. I will do my best to make your son or daughter athletic experience at EVHS a great one for them.

Eagle Valley High School has a lot to offer for all student-athletes during each season. With the fall season we offer Girls Softball, Girls Volleyball, Boys Golf, Boys Soccer, and Football. Practices started on August 6 for golf and all others on August 13. In some sports coaches may have a cut policy and coaches will discuss this with their student-athletes during the first days of camp. Also, the wonderful doctors at the Steadman-Hawkins Clinic provide Athletic Trainers for all our sports at EVHS and they will work with all student-athletics that may sustain an injury during practices and games.

At EVHS we do have an athletic fee that each student-athlete **must pay before they are allowed to participate in an athletic contest**. The fee is \$75 per sport and a maximum of \$350 per family. If you feel that you cannot pay this fee please fill out a free and reduced lunch form and return it to EVHS. We will follow-up and determine if the athletic fee can be waived for your student-athlete.

There will be a Fall Sports Parent Meeting on Monday, August 20 at 7 P.M. in the auditorium. Please plan on attending to get all the information that pertains to the sport that your son or daughter is playing during the fall sports season.
